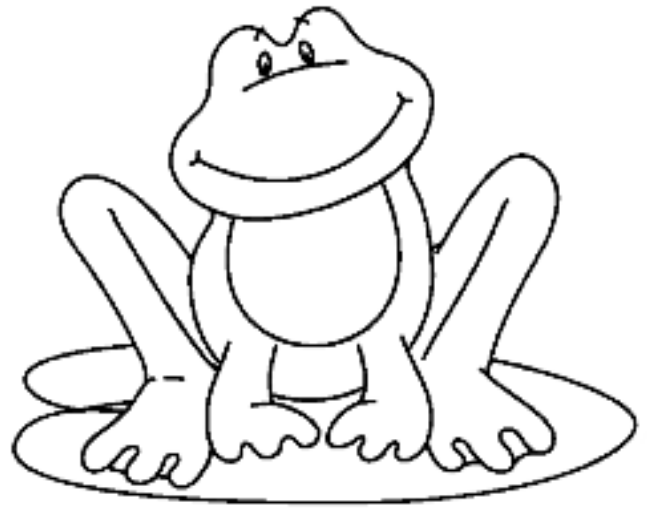
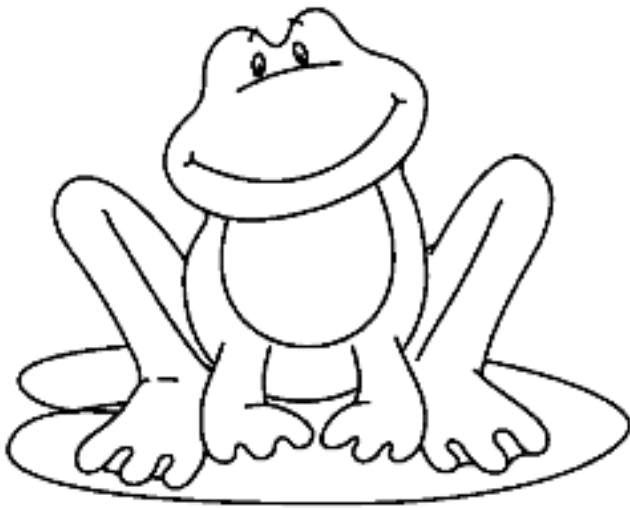


Turtle and Friends

And its feet, and its tail. "I am home, and in bed."

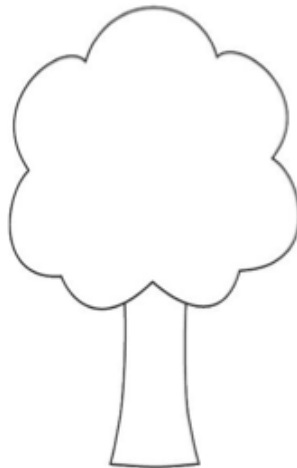
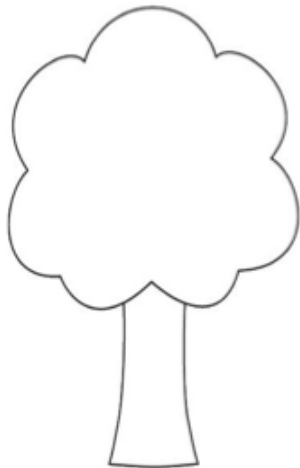
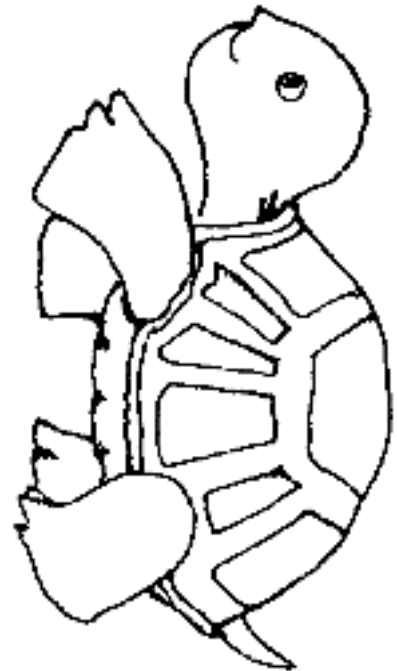
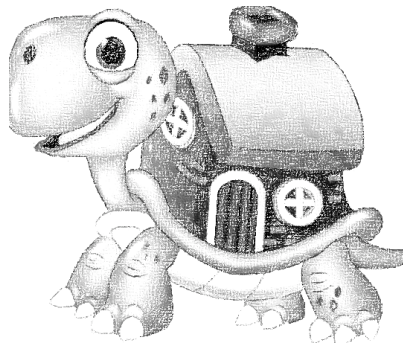
No matter what inches and inches I roam,
